### Your Commitment

We require a 1-year commitment from all our volunteers. This role won't be set days and times, instead, events will be sporadic through the year – such as Saturdays or in school holidays. It may include a week of activities or a one-off afternoon. We want our volunteers to come to as much as possible as to build relationship with the families. Therefore, volunteers for Upbeat Kids will need to have a level of flexibility. New volunteers must also apply to volunteer regularly at the Integration Hub and a DBS will be required.

### Responsibilities

- To create a welcoming environment through setting up the room and helping with clear up at the end of each session.
- To register participants as they arrive, offer them a warm welcome and refreshments.
- To resource and prepare activities beforehand, if leading.
- To connect with the participants, building relationship with them.
- To join in with the activity, ensure everyone is included and help the participants, as necessary.
- To encourage participating families to come to further events and activities.

### **Oualities Needed**

Volunteers will need to be:

- Punctual and committed to good communication with project lead.
- Energetic, enthusiastic and engaging.
- Reliable, responsible and have good communication skills.
- Respectful of those from diverse cultures with different beliefs.
- A good listener and be able to provide emotional support.
- Able to connect with individuals and build community, rather than advise or counsel.

Childcare and children's activities cost a lot of money. Often refugees and asylum seekers have large families and finances are limited.
